

## NEW PRAGUE ICE ARENA COVID-19 PARTICIPANT REGULATIONS

New Prague Area Community Center is committed to providing a safe and healthy recreational facility for our community. To ensure that, we have developed the following regulations in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Our goal is to mitigate the potential for transmission of COVID-19 in our facility, and that requires full cooperation among our visitors. Only through this cooperative effort can we establish and maintain the safety and health of our community.

Our plan follows Centers for Disease Control (“CDC”) guidelines, as interpreted by the Minnesota Department of Health (“MDH”). To the extent that any of these regulations is inconsistent or contrary to CDC or MDH guidelines, those guidelines shall control.

**ALL PERSONS WHO ARE AT RISK OF SEVERE ILLNESS FROM COVID-19 ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO STAY IN THEIR PLACE OF RESIDENCE.**

**IF YOU FEEL SICK, HAVE A COUGH, HAVE TROUBLE BREATHING, OR HAVE SYMPTOMS CONSISTENT WITH COVID-19, YOU SHOULD STAY HOME AND NOT ENGAGE OR ATTEND.**

*New Prague Area Community Center has live video streaming of all arena events through LiveBarn. We recommend our parents, families and friends consider following the action through our partner wherever possible.*

1. Anyone entering the facility agrees to submit to random temperature checks without notice.
2. Appropriate social distancing at all times is required. Please attempt to keep at least 6’ away from others whenever possible.
3. Visitors are instructed to cover their mouth and nose with their sleeve or a tissue when coughing or sneezing and to avoid touching their face, in particular their mouth, nose and eyes, with their hands, and dispose of tissues in the trash and wash or sanitize their hands immediately afterward.
4. Utilize touchless handwashing in the restrooms and hand sanitizer stations whenever possible, and particularly when entering and exiting the facility.
5. The facility is an indoor facility, and all visitors are required to wear masks indoors unless engaged in strenuous workouts on the ice itself. **All individuals in locker rooms, in the spectator areas of the arena and its corridors, and in the lobby must have appropriate face coverings at all times.**

6. The arena has developed an appropriate one-way only pattern of foot traffic within the lobby, the facility and its corridors. Please respect the marked signs to reduce contacts among other visitors.
7. The arena has a limited capacity under Minnesota law. Spectators and guests shall be limited. **Currently: Maximum of 1 chaperone or spectator per participant. This includes siblings.**
8. ALL user groups must submit a plan for social distancing and monitoring the health status of group members related to COVID-19. All user groups must log all participants for every ice session each day.
9. All participants should have their own water bottles. Water fountains are not accessible.
10. Storage of equipment is not allowed. All equipment should be removed after each use.
11. Spitting is prohibited anywhere in the arena. No chewing gum is permitted inside the facility.
12. It is recommended that players arrive half-dressed in hockey gear. **Except for Minnesota Hockey or USA Hockey guidelines which require arrival no more than 15 minutes before icetime starts, all other participants all participants must be in their locker rooms at least 15 minutes before their scheduled ice times.** NO LATECOMERS. You are requested to remain in the locker room until your scheduled ice time. Showers are unavailable.
13. **Leave the facility dressed no more than 15 minutes after your ice time maintaining distancing, especially with those entering the arena.** Loitering and socializing in the ice arena after your ice time is prohibited. We recommend participants clean and disinfect all gear after each use.

**FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EJECTION FROM THE FACILITY AND/OR RESTRICTIONS ON FUTURE ICE AVAILABILITY.**
